

Sick Child Procedure

This procedure, which applies to the whole school inclusive of the Early Years Foundation Stage, is in support of the health and safety policy and the individual health and safety assessments. This policy is publicly available on the school's website. On request a copy may be obtained from the school's office.

Sick children are always cared for in the most comforting manner. The children are brought to the School Office where they are seen by the School Secretary, Lisa Dawson (Qualified Paediatric First Aider) and assessment is made and first aid is administered.

When children are too sick to remain at school, parents/carers are contacted and child is kept comfortable with water, blankets and any other treatment relevant to the individual case, until parent/carer can collect the child.

If children need to be taken to the local A&E then parents/carers are contacted and a member of staff travels with the child to the hospital.
